DURATION: 5 HOURS OR MORE

Phase I

Magens Bay Beach (Second Stop)

This one mile wonder with Atlantic Ocean waters splashing its waves on the shoreline, has been rated one of the most beautiful beaches in the world. Filled with amenities. This island treasure was donated to the Virgin Islands Government by Arthur Fairchild in 1946. Restrooms are conveniently located on the beach.



Coki Point Beach (Third Stop)

This beach has the best snorkeling and it has been said to have mythical healing properties. The location of the only underwater observatory on island, Coral World is steps away from the beach. You can enjoy parasailing, and jet skiing and a variety of foods. Restrooms are conveniently located on the beach.



Sapphire Bay Beach (Fourth Stop)

This is a hotel resort beach so there are all the conveniences you would expect. One simply gorgeous beach that will entice you with its slopes and romantic hideaways. The Atlantic Ocean and Caribbean Sea seamlessly merge in front of your very eyes.
